Hebrews

Passages where the Lord Jesus is spoken of simply as Jesus, His characteristic Name in this important epistle. It accentuates His Manhood, He is the Man in the glory:

1. Jesus, made a little lower than the angels, but now crowned with glory and honor (Heb. 2:9).
2. Jesus, the Author or Captain of our salvation (Heb. 2:10-18).
3. Christ Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession (Heb. 3:1-6).
4. Our great High Priest, Jesus the Son of God (Heb. 4:14-16).
5. He is a Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek (Heb. 5:5 - 7:19).
6. Jesus has become the surety of a better covenant (Heb. 7:20-28).
7. We have boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way (Heb. 10:1-25).
8. Jesus, the Author and Finisher, or Leader and Completer of our faith (Heb. 12:1-2).
9. Jesus, the Center of attraction without the camp of Judaism (Heb. 13:8-16).
